#### CITB Tuition Funding Subsidy\*

The subsidy provided by the Construction Industry Training Board (CITB) is available to those apprentices who are classified as being employed within the Construction Industry. This subsidy is paid direct to the employer to offset the costs of trade school. Contact CITB for details around T&Cs for Tuition Funding.

#### Concessions

Concessions may be granted to students who have a relevant concession card at the time of enrolment; subject to the student being eligible for funding under WorkReady.

Concessions cannot be applied for after enrolment.

#### JobTrainer Concession#

The job trainer funding is available from 15 October 2020 to 31 December 2022 and is subject to three qualifying factors:

- 1) out of work
- 2) receiving and income support payment
- 3) aged 16-24 and not at school

JobTrainer concession for this qualification reduces the total Training fee to \$280.00. This is invoiced in advance.
