This work-entry program will teach you the basic skills and knowledge to work safely in any of the primary trades in the building and construction industry.

The skills you learn in this course will put you on the right path to becoming a carpenter, bricklayer, concreter etc.



OUTCOMES AND CREDITS

Once you've completed all your Units of Competency, you'll receive a **CPC20220 Certificate II in Construction Pathways** qualification. If not all Units of Competency are completed, a Statement of Attainment will be issued instead.



ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To complete this course, you should have a good understanding of both **English** and **General Mathematics.**



WHAT YOU'LL NEED
